ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Students must take ILSC's Pre-Registration Online Language Assessment (PROLA).

YOUR PATHWAY TO SUCCESS

ILSC UNIVERSITY PATHWAY PROGRAM

8–24 weeks

Gain the language ability and academic skills needed to succeed in college or university

COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY PROGRAM

1–4 years

College and university students can work 20 hours per week

POST-GRADUATE WORK PERMIT*

1–3 years depending on length of study

PERMANENT RESIDENT*

Apply for PR after 1 year of post-graduation work experience. Receive PR usually within 3–12 months.
